The ladies had their first organizational meeting. The schedule has been created for the upcoming golf season. We invite any lady CCC member to join the LGA.





FROM THE PRO SHOP cont.

Harry Vardon once said, "For this game you need, above all things, to be in a tranquil frame of mind." This game is a reflection of the circle of life as no matter what you shoot, the next day you have to go back to the first tee and begin all over again trying to make yourself into something. Remember, enjoy it out there and relax doing so.

That is the beauty of this game. No matter what happens on Saturday, you can do it again on Sunday and hope for better results. And when playing with friends, know that handicaps are the measuring stick to determine who plays golf well and those who may not play so well. But, no matter who is playing, the field is evened out because of handicaps and that is what makes this game so great. And relating to handicaps, there is a new way to check your scores, post and check stats. Hope you enjoyed that segue into changing how you post scores.

The West Virginia Golf Association launched its new app that will replace the current USGA GHIN Application. Before you delete the GHIN app, please open it up and go to MORE at the bottom right as it has three dots right above it. From there, go to "My Card" and your current card will appear. PLEASE COPY DOWN YOUR GHIN NUMBER as it is located right below the USGA GHIN logo. You will need that and your last name to log into the WVGA app. Once you are active, then delete the GHIN app. The WVGA has the seasonal tourney schedule and many other additives to keep you informed of golf throughout the state. The app is free to download.

This year, we are going to allow golfers to register online for MGA events as the link will be sent through email to those who wish to play. This will include the 2-man and President's Cup matches as each event will be sent through a google form document and automatically sent to my computer letting me know that you are playing. We will still have the paper

sign-up sheets outside the pro shop but through this technology, players can do it without having to call the shop or time will not allow to get out there and physically do it.

As the winter wraps up, I will be getting some work done in the Pro Shop as some needed repairs to the building needs to be recognized. Speaking with the Golf and Maintenance committees we plan to create some extra workspace in the back room, which is the priority of the projects needed. We should see the additions and the improvements in process this month. I mention this as this may eat up some space including bag storage and range balls. We hope that the project will be complete by April 1st, no fooling!

The tournament schedule is ready for this year and with some scheduling maneuvering we are looking to add a couple more events to the calendar. Those will most likely be cash games, and in discussion with the Golf Committee one of the events could include outside play with green and cart fees as well as more players will allow for more revenue for the club. We will discuss this further during the next GC meeting.

Finally, on March 30th, there will be a "meet and greet" for the MGA as the Golf Committee, myself and Course Superintendent Brady Hatch will be there to give a preview of the golf calendar of events and to answer questions and listen to suggestions about events. It is a great opportunity to meet Hatch and listen to his plan of action for the coming year. The Board has great confidence in his hiring and they are very supportive of him and his staff.

We expect a great year this year as we are continuing to grow. Contact me for all your golfing needs ... *Doug*

Established in 1912, the Clarksburg Country Club (CCC) is one of West Virginia's oldest premier private golf clubs. Tom Bendelow, a Scottish-American golf architect (1868-1936) who was nicknamed "The Johnny Appleseed of American Golf" designed CCC as a nine-hole course surrounded by the West Fork River among 600 other course designs in a 35 year span. Later, CCC added an additional nine-holes crossing the West Fork River known as the backside. The course features a challenging 6,000-yard, 18-hole golf course nestled in peaceful surroundings. Other amenities include a Junior Olympic Size swimming pool, tennis & basketball courts and club house facilities with separate Pro Shop.
