





PRACTICE RANGE / PRIVATE CARTS

The Golf Practice Range is scheduled to open for the season on Monday, April 1! In recent years, Golfing Members were privileged to unlimited use of the practice area. Before that, the members were offered a variety of range plans to purchase balls for practice. After careful consideration, the Board plan to bring back the range plan program beginning in 2024. The added expenses related to the practice area like restocking inventory (balls and bags) weighed in this decision. On average, the club has lost around 3,000 range balls and 60 range bags a year. And the board would like to direct those dollars spent on the range for improvements of the property. So, the purchases made to improve your game will be used to improve the facilities. It was not an easy decision but a necessary one.

This range plan will be <u>available where ANY CCC</u>
<u>Member in Good Standing</u>. The variety of packages include single bag (40 balls), mini packages and even a seasonal pass. Please let the Pro Shop or Shannon in the office know what Plan you want to purchase, and it will be Charged to your account. You will be provided a Card with your name and Plan. You will be providing your card to the Pro Shop upon receiving a supply of bags & balls. Your card will be returned to you upon return of the range ball bag(s). The Range card can only be used by you. <u>NOTE:</u> Your Plan must be paid for within 30 days, or your privileges will be suspended.

Range Card Plan 2024

Single Bag- 40 balls - \$5

Packages 10 Bags - \$45

20 Bags - \$80

50 Bags - \$150

Unlimited Season - \$200

Golf Cart Private:

Clarksburg Country Club Trail Fees of \$300 will be billed in May for each Golfing Membership (single or married) using a privately owned golf cart. A Yellow sticker numbered consecutive will be assigned to each member to be prominently displayed on each Members Golf Cart. A trail fee will need to be purchased for each golf cart used on the golf course.

Also, we have received requests from Golfing Members who prefer to ride alone in their Golf Carts for either preference or a medical condition. To accommodate, beginning in 2024, The CCC Board approved allowing these Members the right to ride alone in their Golf Cart for a total Trail Fee of \$600. To distinguish the difference, each single rider will be given a separate orange sticker numbered consecutively to be assigned to and displayed on the respective Members Golf Cart. This decision is on a trial basis, and this will be reviewed and evaluated throughout the year to determine if it will be practiced in the future. To elaborate, Four (4) Carts with Single Riders with these privileges will be allowed to ride alone in a Foursome if all have purchased the Single rider Trail fee.

Every member owned golf cart being used here at Clarksburg Country Club must display either a yellow or an orange sticker on the golf cart at ALL times. If any cart is found without a sticker displayed could result in the cart being removed from the grounds of the club.



COURSE NEWS

So glad that we're turning the corner on the weather

and hope that this season is full of sunshine and dry grounds.

I want to thank all members for being patient with us during the aerification process. This is a necessary treatment that has to be done.

Here are our plans for this spring: aerify the greens, verticut the fairways after the first mow, slice the rough and we plan to fix the drainage on the course though out the year. As you know we've already accomplished aerifying the greens.

Our fall plans are to once again aerify the greens, drain the pond at 17 and fix the edges, add drainage to at least one green through winter drainage and add all white sand to ravines at 10 to make a continuous fairway. We're also going to burn the debris piles, mow all rough grass down to 3 inches and continue to add drainage.

Also, we ask that you please avoid parking next to the Maintenance building and gas pumps.

Our crew needs access to those areas.
