

POOL RULES

Clarksburg Country Club Pool Rules

Hours of Operation - Monday-Friday - 12:00 pm - 8:00 pm

Saturday & Sunday - 11:00am - 8:00pm

The last whistle will blow at 7:45 pm, please gather all belongings.

- All Members & Guests must check in before entering the pool. Guest Fees at \$7.00 per person per day. All guests must be accompanied by a member. Children no longer living at home of members are considered guests.
- Outside Food & Beverages are strictly prohibited from being brought onto the grounds.
- Local Adult guests within Harrison County are permitted to use the pool facilities six (6) times per season. Minor
 guests (17 & under) are permitted unlimited guest visits when accompanied by a member.
- Babysitters must be registered with the Club Office and Lifeguards.
- All kids under the age of 12 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Swim Attire

- Swimming attire is one or two-piece suits for women and trunks for men. Infants in the pool need only to wear trunks or suitable coverings.
- Outside the pool area, it is recommended that you wear a coverup or shirt and trunks with sandals. Coverups / shirts and shoes required if entering the clubhouse.

Pool Locker Room

- The Club or Staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items at the pool.
- No smoking will be permitted anywhere inside the gated area of the pool. If you choose to smoke, please do so outside of the pool area.

Pool

- Whistles will be used only when necessary to gain the attention of the swimmer(s).
- Non-swimmers must remain in shallow water areas. To be permitted in deep water areas, a swimmer must be able to swim the pool width with ease.

POOL RULES contd.

- Chewing gum in the pool is not permitted.
- PLEASE No Jumping, Diving or Horseplay in the general swimming area.
- All swim and play equipment (rafts, flotation devices, pool noodles) will be permitted but the staff or club is not responsible for lost or damaged items. WE WILL NOT STORE any items brought in by the members.

Staff

- The Pool Manager/Lifeguards have the authority to control the conduct and activities of persons in the pool area. Guards will follow the procedures for warning the swimmer and benching the swimmer from the pool for the first rule infraction. If violations of the rules continue, the swimmer will be suspended and the parents/guardians will be notified.
- Lifeguards have the authority to forgo the usual warnings, and bench/suspend the swimmer from the pool immediately, if the situation warrants the decision.
- There will be no swimming in the pool without Lifeguards present. And all early morning swimmers MUST register with the Pool Committee and sign a waiver.

Swim Deck (Grass & Concrete Areas)

- No Running, no bikes or scooters around the pool deck.
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND.
- No Eating in the pool.
- Pushing or pulling others into the pool is not permitted.
- Snapping towels, spitting, pinching or other horseplay is not permitted.
- Please use the diving area/diving board when jumping into the water.
- If you move the pool furniture, please make sure to return to its original spot.
- Please cleanup around your area before you leave.
- Small children must be accompanied by an adult into the restrooms.
- No oversized flotation devices will be permitted unless the guards okay it.
- You Must Get Written Approval from the Board if you plan to have portable tents, sun umbrellas or any other item for sun protection. NOTE – YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY IF CAUSED BY YOUR PROPERTY.

The last whistle will blow at 8:00 pm, please gather all belongings and exit by 8:30 pm.

This allows the Life Guards time to prepare the pool for the next day.
